 - RE: A Resource for an End-of-the-Year Blessing of Catechists

Enclosed please find a resource for you to consider using as you see fit some time this spring. The action suggested by this resource is part of an effort to change a culture that many catechetical leaders are encountering.

Many parish catechetical leaders (PCLs) tell me that most of their catechists are happy to teach in the faith formation program but unwilling to participate in any additional activities—even small ones—that address the catechist's own need for ongoing formation in content, methods, facilitation skills etc.. As a move toward encouraging a culture of formation, certification and renewal of catechists, I am offering the enclosed blessing of catechists for you to consider using—especially as we move toward a catechetical certification effort at the archdiocesan level.

This blessing could be used near the end of Mass at your discretion, or in another setting like an end-of-the-year celebration for catechists and their families. (I know that several parishes have such an annual event.)

Thanks for your support of excellent catechesis in your parish, as well as the encouragement you give to all adults who want to grow in their knowledge of the Faith and their disciple relationship with Jesus. May His teaching presence continue transforming the hearts and minds of the faithful in your parish.

The following is designed for use near the end of Mass or at any gathering of catechists and their families:
