landed employment and started saving her money. She was a single mom of two beautiful children. She managed to work a full-time job, take care of her children and maintain a home after leaving Becky's Place. We were all so proud of her!

Life took an unexpected and sad turn in June for Carrie and Shayla's family. Carrie was called

to the hospital to find Shayla clinging to life and on life support. Carrie reached out to her Becky's Place family for support. Within hours, two members of our staff, Corrina and Natalie, were at the hospital by Carrie's side. On June 26th, Carrie made the hardest decision that any parent would ever be faced with. Carrie had to take her baby girl off life support.

Remembering Shayla. Shayla was a strong, intelligent, and beautiful young lady. The staff at Becky's Place had the privilege to be able to see her achieve so many milestones in her life: graduating from high school, reuniting with her mother, becoming a mother and becoming a wonderful woman and friend. Shayla was just 22 years old when she passed away.

Our shelter program was awarded a \$1,370 Safe and Secure Home grant from the Lawrence County Community Foundation's Board of Directors. Funding for this grant will be used to maintain a clean and healthy environment at Becky's Place.
