



Holy Family Shelter Christmas Wish List

Thank you for considering the families at Holy Family Shelter in your shopping list this holiday season. We are often asked about “adopting a family” at Christmas time. We discourage this due to serving twenty-two families each night. Our past experience indicates that when one family is singled out to receive Christmas gifts the other families feel left out and the receiving family is often the target of envy.

Therefore, we ask that if you wish to help our families at Christmas to please donate new toys, clothes and gifts (*see list below*). We prefer that these items are not wrapped as we allow the parents to choose what they want to give their children from the donations and then let them wrap the gifts themselves. This allows the parents to feel like they have a part in their children’s Christmas, not just receiving a handout. We also have the children choose gifts for their parents. The children wrap these gifts as well.

Suggested Christmas Gift List

- * Winter Coats
- * New clothing (all sizes infant to adult)
- * Gift Cards (Walmart, Kroger, Speedway Gas, etc.)
- * Dolls of all ethnicities
- * New undergarments for children & adults (underwear, bras, socks, etc.)
- * Inexpensive MP3 type radios (teenagers love them!)
- * Soccer balls, basketballs, & footballs
- * Perfume / Cologne
- * Address books, calendars & journals
- * Wallets, inexpensive watches & jewelry (men & women)
- * Infant toys
- * Pajamas & slippers
- * New toys-age appropriate (please no violent video games or DVD’s)
- * Alarm clocks
- * Board & card games
- * Winter boots
- * Christmas gift bags, scotch tape, name tags & scissors
- * Batteries

Please note that we usually receive a large amount of toys for infants, toddlers, and younger children. We also serve approximately 200 homeless teenagers each year. The teens are often left out due to minimal “age appropriate” gifts. Small radios (MP3 type), sports related clothing (Colts & Pacers), and inexpensive watches & jewelry are big hits with the teens.
