### INDIVIDUAL & FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES

**Individual, Couple and Family Counseling**, Phone (317) 236-1500 Professional counseling is available on a sliding fee scale, based on income.

#### School Social Work, Phone (317)236-1523

Professional counseling services are provided for school children along with consultation services for teachers and parents.

#### **SJA – Neighborhood Youth Outreach Program (NYO)**, Phone (317) 283-6710 Activities such as after school and summer programs serve urban youth and their families in the St. Joan of Arc neighborhood.

## ELDERCARE SERVICES

RSVP (Retired & Senior Volunteer Program) works as a clearinghouse of volunteer opportunities for adults 55 and over. Volunteers have the flexibility to decide where to serve and how frequently.
