What are NAP Credits?

Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP) Tax Credits are awarded to non-profit organizations that serve economically disadvantaged populations. NAP Credits are great for both the donor and the agency as the donor is eligible for a tax credit through the State of Indiana of up to 50% of the contribution. Unlike a tax deduction, NAP credits are applied to your Indiana state tax liability.

How will my donation be used?

Your designated donation will be used to support either:

- *Terre Haute Catholic Charities Foodbank* collects, warehouse, and distributes more than 2 million meals each year through a network of member agencies in Clay, Greene, Knox, Parke, Sullivan, Vermillion, and Vigo counties.
- *Bethany House Emergency Shelter* provides temporary housing, food, clothing, laundry facilities, and counseling to single women, married couples, single parents with children, and families.

Who is eligible to receive NAP Credits?

Eligible donors include any person, business, or organization that has an Indiana income tax liability. Additionally, because Catholic Charities is recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)3 organization, a NAP contribution may also be taken as a federal tax deduction. (Consult your tax advisor about your specific situation.)

What is the minimum contribution amount?

Donations must be at least \$100 in order to be eligible to receive NAP Credits. You may donate in smaller increments and be able to qualify for NAP Credits once your total contribution for the fiscal year (beginning July 1, 2011) equals at least \$100. However, NAP Credits are not secured until your donation equals \$100 and are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

How do I receive the Credits?

Please fill out form NC-10 which is available on our website, www.CatholicCharitiesTerreHaute.org or by contacting Jennifer Buell at (812)232-1447, and mail it to Catholic Charities along with your contribution. Our agency will file the required information with the Indiana Department of Revenue. You will receive an acknowledgement letter from Catholic Charities to use with your annual tax return.
