4021	Black & Native American Missions – This account is used to record income for moneys received from the Propagation of the Faith second collection.
4022	Aid for Church in Eastern Europe – This account is used to record income for moneys received from the Aid for Church in Eastern Europe second collection.
4023	U.S. Bishops Overseas Aid Appeal – This account is used to record income for moneys received from the U.S. Bishops Overseas Aid Appeal second collection.
4024	Holy Places – This account is used to record income for moneys received from the Holy Places second collection.
4025	<u>Catholic Home Missions Appeal</u> – This account is used to record income for moneys received from the Catholic Home Missions Appeal second collection.
4026	Education of Future Archdiocesan Priests – This account is used to record income for moneys received from the Education of Future Archdiocesan Priests second collection.
4027	Peter's Pence – This account is used to record income for moneys received from the Peter's Pence second collection.
4028	World Mission Sunday – This account is used to record income for moneys received from the World Mission Sunday second collection.
4029	<u>Campaign for Human Development</u> – This account is used to record income for moneys received from the Campaign for Human Development second collection.

4040 Donations-Other – This account is used to record all donations received, other than those that could be categorized in the above. 4041 Archdiocese Donations – This account is used to record all donations received from the Archdiocese. 4042 Corporate Donations – This account is used to record all donations from corporate entities. 4043 Individual Donations – This account is used to record all donations from individuals that are not part of the Archdiocese or corporate entities. 4045 Stole Fees – This account is used to record income from stole fees, such as fees charges for performing baptisms, funerals, wedding ceremonies, etc. 4050 Votive Offerings – This account is used to record revenue derived from candle votive offerings. 4052 Religious Articles – This account is used to record revenues from the sale or free will donation of religious articles, such as rosaries, crosses etc. 4054 Literature/Pamphlets – This account is used to record moneys received from the sale or free will donation for religious literature and/or pamphlets. Memorials – This account is used to record moneys received for memorial 4056 contributions. Criterion Subscriptions – This account is used to record revenue given to 4060 the parish for Criterion subscriptions. 4100 Development Income – This account is used to record revenue received from development activities.

4210	<u>Parishioner Tuition</u> – This account is used to record <i>gross</i> tuition revenue from parishioners.
4212	Non-Parishioner Tuition – This account is used to record <i>gross</i> tuition revenue from non-parishioners.
4214	Non-Catholic Tuition – This account is used to record <i>gross</i> tuition revenue from non-Catholic students.
4215	<u>Government Tuition</u> – This account is used to record <i>gross</i> tuition revenue from government organizations
4220	Kindergarten Tuition – This account is used to record <i>gross</i> tuition revenue for kindergarten students.
4230	<u>Pre-School Tuition</u> – This account is used to record <i>gross</i> tuition revenue for pre-school students.
4231	<u>Financial Aid received from Archdiocese & Making a Difference</u> – This account is used to record <i>gross</i> tuition revenue from the Archdiocese and Making a Difference.
4232	<u>Financial Aid received from ECCT (Choice)</u> – This account is used to record <i>gross</i> tuition revenue from ECCT (Choice).
4240	Other Tuition – This account is used to record <i>gross</i> tuition revenue for students involved in other instructional activities.
<u>Fees</u>	
4250	<u>Day Care</u> – This account is used to record moneys received for day care services.
4255	Extended Care – This account is used to record moneys received for extended care services (both before and after care).
4260	<u>Summer Program Fees</u> – This account is used to record fees received for summer programs (i.e. vacation Bible school).
4270	Babysitting – This account is used to record moneys received for babysitting services provided.
4310	Registration Fees – This account is used to record the receipt of fees for registration in various programs.
4320 4330	Book Fees – This account is used to record the receipt of fees for books. Sacramental Fees – This account is used to record the receipt of money for fees associated with the sacraments.
4340	<u>Program Fees</u> – This account is used to record revenue received for programs.

Fundraising

<u>Fundraising Activities</u> – This account is used to record the income-side of a fundraising activity. 4400

<u>Charity Gaming Revenue</u> – This account is used to record any 4500 sales/revenue made specifically in conjunction with a licensed charity gaming event held by the parish or any of its' ministries.

<u>Sales</u>

4600	<u>Sales</u> – This account is used to record the receipt of money for any items sold by the parish or its' ministries, excluding advertising/marketing sales, vending sales, bookstore sales and cafeteria sales (see below).
4605	Advertising/Marketing Sales – This account is used to record income received from the sales of advertising or marketing e.g. church bulletin.
4610	Vending Sales – This account is used to record any money earned
	through any vending machines on parish property.
4620	Bookstore Sales - This account is used to record the receipt of money
	from the sales of items at a bookstore e.g. books, supplies, clothing
4630	Cafeteria Sales – This account is used to record cafeteria receipts from
	daily cafeteria sales.
4635	Government Reimbursement - Cafeteria - This account is used to record
	reimbursements to the cafeteria by the various governmental lunch
	programs.

Other

4640	<u>CYO Income</u> – This account is used to record moneys received at the
	parish for CYO activities.
4650	Other Athletic Income – This account is used to record moneys relating to
	athletics, other than CYO revenues.
4660	Rental Income - This account is used to record revenue received from the
	rental of any parish property, including lots, conference rooms, banquet
	halls, etc.
4670	Cemetery Income – This account is used to record income received from
	the sale of cemetery plots and crypts and/or income for the purposes of
	maintaining its' grounds.
4710	Miscellaneous Income - This account is used to record other income that
	cannot be categorized in the above.
4880	Related Organization Income - This account is used to record

4820 Interest Income - This account is used to record any interest that a parish receives on an interest bearing checking or savings account. Please note that this account should not be used to record ADLF or CCF interest.

	chosen to receive.
4861	Capital Grants for Programs – This account is used to record any capital
	grants for which the parish or one of it's ministries has applied for and
	received or was chosen to receive.
4862	Other Grants for Programs – This account is used to record any
	extraordinary grants for which the parish or one of it's ministries has
	applied for and received or was chosen to receive.
4863	Government Grants – This account is used to record any governmental
	grants for which the parish or one of it's ministries has applied for and
	received or was chosen to receive.
