PILGRIMAGE TO CALIFORNIA

SEPTEMBER 25 INDIANAPOLIS / SAN FRANCISCO

Depart Indianapolis International Airport for San Francisco. Upon arrival at San Francisco International Airport you are met, assisted and transferred to Pier 39 a famous landmark, home to wonderful dining, shopping and entertainment. After lunch, enjoy a three-hour sightseeing tour of San Francisco and a visit to **San Francisco De Asis (Mission Dolores)**. This mission, originally located on the Bay, served as an important naval base for the Spaniards to protect their colony from outside invaders. It is now located in downtown San Francisco. After checking into **The Hilton San Francisco Union Square**, you will venture to **Chinatown** for a group dinner. Overnight at The Hilton San Francisco, ideally located near shopping and restaurants. **(Meal: D)**



SEPTEMBER 26 MISSION SAN RAFAEL ARCANGEL / MOUNT TAMALPAIS STATE PARK / TIBURON / FERRY

Begin your journey today with a visit and Mass at **Mission San Rafael Arcangel**, which served as a convalescent hospital for the many sick neophytes (Christianized Native Americans) there. Continue on to **Mount Tamalpais State Park** for spectacular views after a drive to the top of Mount Tamalpais. Next, visit **Tiburon**, a small town on the Bay. Main Street's buildings date from Gold Rush Days. After free time for lunch on the pier, take the ferry back across the Bay to San Francisco where the motorcoach will be waiting to drive you back to the hotel. Dinner is on your own this evening at one of the many fine restaurants within walking distance of the hotel. Overnight at **The Hilton San Francisco Union Square**. **(B)**

SEPTEMBER 27 SONOMA / WINERY / MISSION SAN FRANCISCO SOLANO

This morning, travel through the vineyards of Sonoma's wine country. You will also tour the **Mission San Francisco Solano**, the only mission founded after Mexico's independence from Spain. Enjoy a short walking tour around the town square before driving onto **Napa** to tour **Andretti Winery**. Overnight at **Embassy Suites** in Napa. **(B)**

SEPTEMBER 28 NAPA/MONTEREY

After morning at leisure and lunch on your own in **Napa**, depart for **Mondavi Winery** and then **Monterey** arriving early evening. Overnight at **Portola Resort and Spa** in Monterey. **(B)**

SEPTEMBER 29 MISSION SANTA CRUZ / MISSION SAN JUAN BAUTISTA / CARMEL / PEBBLE BEACH / 17 MILE DRIVE / MONTEREY

Drive along the Monterey Bay to Santa Cruz and head for a visit and Mass at **Mission Santa Cruz**, which sits on a gentle slope surrounded by the beautiful redwood trees not far from where they meet the Pacific Ocean. You'll then have a short drive to Felton to board a narrow-gauge steam engine. Travel over trestles through towering redwood groves and up a narrow-gauge grade to the summit of **Bear Mountain** and back to Roaring Camp for a BBQ lunch. After this historic train ride, you'll visit **Mission San Juan Bautista** before returning to Monterey in the afternoon and continuing to popular Carmel by the Sea. Free-time to check out the shops, drive by Pebble Beach Resort and along the famous coastal **17 Mile Drive** with its gorgeous seascapes, returning to **Monterey** for another night. Farewell Dinner.

Overnight at **Portola Hotel and Spa** in Monterey. **(B,L,D)**

SEPTEMBER 30 MISSION SAN JOSE / SAN FRANCISCO / HOME

It's an early morning departure as you head for a visit to **Mission San Jose** with Mass (Mission Santa Clara De Asis can be substituted on this day.) Proceed back to the San Francisco airport to arrive two hours prior to departure. **(B)**
