

Biographical/Historical Note

The Right Reverend Célestin René Laurent Guynemer de la Hailandière, Second Bishop of Vincennes was born in Combourg, Archdiocese of Rennes on May 3, 1798. De la Hailandière was an ordained priest in Paris on May 28, 1825 and became Vicar general of the Diocese of Vincennes on 1839. He was named bishop coadjutor of Vincennes on May 17, 1839 and consecrated in Paris on August 18, 1839 by Bishop Charles Forbin-Janson of Nancy, assisted by Bishop Louis Blanquart de Bailleuil of Versailles and Bishop Jean Louis la Mercier of Beauvais. De la Hailandière resigned July 16, 1847, and returned to France. He died on May 1, 1882. His body was brought from France and interred in the Old Cathedral, Vincennes, on November 22, 1882.

The Right Reverend John Stephan Bazin, Third Bishop of Vincennes was born in Duerne, Archdiocese of Lyons, France on October 15, 1796. Bazin was ordained priest at Lyons, July 22, 1822. He came to the United States in 1830 and was appointed vicar general of Mobile and consecrated bishop of Vincennes in the cathedral at Vincennes, October 24, 1847, by Bishop Michael Portier of Mobile, assisted by Bishop

Purcell of Cincinnati and Bishop de la Hailandière, his predecessor. Bazin died at Vincennes on April 23, 1848 and His body is interred in the Old Cathedral, Vincennes.

The Right Reverend Jacques M. Maurice Landes D'Aussac de Saint-Palais was born at LaSalvetat, France on November 15, 1811. De Saint Palais was ordained priest at Paris, May 28, 1836. He became the administrator of the diocese after the death of Bishop Bazin and named bishop of Vincennes on October 3, 1848. De Saint Palais was consecrated in the cathedral at Vincennes, January 14, 1849, by Bishop Pius Miles, OP, of Nashville, assisted by Coadjutor Bishop Martin John Spalding of Louisville and Very Reverend Hippolyte Du Pontavice, vicar general of Vincennes. De Saint Palais died at St. Mary-of-the-Woods, June 28, 1877. His body is interred in the Old Cathedral, Vincennes.

Scope & Content Note

This collection consists of materials regarding Célestin René Laurent Guynemer de la Hailandière, John Stephan Bazin and Jacques M. Maurice Landes D'Aussac de Saint Palais including those written by him, correspondence addressed to him, and content written about him. These documents provide historical, pictorial, and other information about the life of Célestin René Laurent Guynemer de la Hailandière, John Stephan Bazin and Jacques M. Maurice Landes D'Aussac de Saint Palais, the history of the early Church in Indiana.

Arrangement

The collection is arranged by series, with the first series pertaining to de la Hailandière and Bazin, with the second pertaining to Saint Palais.
