Last year, Terri Jones* came to the **Crisis Office** because she needed food, clothing and help purchasing birth certificates for her two grandchildren who had moved in with her and her husband. (Birth certificates are required when applying for Medicaid coverage, food stamps and any other benefits that the family might be entitled to receive.) Terri also needed help obtaining furniture for the children's bedroom.

The Crisis Office immediately responded with clothing, food and the money for two birth certificates. Additionally, we provided a referral to St. Vincent DePaul for bedroom furniture.

The Jones family returned the following week to personally thank us and give us an update on all the blessings they had received. The bedroom furniture had been delivered. Terri's grandchildren had adjusted well to their new school. Terri



was able to apply for Medicaid and food stamps for the children and had been told that they should qualify.

Office can help in a pinch. Every now and then, we provide basic needs since Terri's husband was diagnosed with some serious health issues and is in treatment at the VA hospital. With the help of the Crisis Office,

the Joneses can avoid crises and focus on their time together.
