Service Line Review



Crisis Relief & Shelter Services:

- Holy Family Services: Assisted over 300 families with shelter and transitional housing needs. *Find us on Facebook at "Holy Family Shelter"*
- The Crisis Office: Helped almost 37,000 family members in need of food, clothing, transportation and utility assistance.
- The Christmas Store: Allowed over 800 families in need to come and shop for clothes and gifts for Christmas.
- **Refugee and Immigration Services**: Aided over 800 refugees in coming to the United States. It helped almost 1,300 people with immigration service and support as well as 500 people with job placement. *Find us on Facebook at "Catholic Charities Indianapolis refugee and Immigrant Services"*

Senior Services:



- **RVSP**: Assisted 150 seniors in finding volunteer opportunities. Approx. 50,000 people are impacted by the service of RSVP volunteers.
- **Caregiver Support**: 135 caregivers participated in support groups for those caring for adults aged 60 and older. These support groups allow care givers to feel less isolated, improve coping skills, and increase knowledge of resources.
- Adult Day Services: Provided a therapeutic, safe day care for almost 40 adults with physical and/or cognitive impairments.
- Senior Companions: Provided the gift of friendship and home visits to 125 homebound clients and over 1500 hours of service a week in the community. Catholic Charities Indianapolis sponsors the Senior Companion Program. The Corporation for National & Community Service, a federal agency, provides major funds and administers the SCP.



Family Services:

- Counseling: Provided over 350 individuals, families and couples with professional counseling services over the last year.
- School Social Work: Provided professional counseling services to over 2,500 school children in Indianapolis Catholic schools along with consultation services for teachers and parents.
- **Neighborhood Youth Outreach**: Impacted over 400 children that participated in after school and summer programs in the St. Joan of Arc neighborhood. This includes over 100 people that received community meals.
