In a 4-4 affirmation of the 5th Circuit Court's decision, the U.S. Supreme Court today effectively blocked President Barack Obama's November 20, 2014 executive orders on Deferred Action. These executive orders included Deferred Action for Parents of children with U.S. Citizenship or Lawful Permanent Resident status (DAPA) and Expanded DACA. This means that the Deferred Action programs will not go into effect, but rather return to the lower court for further review.
