Cost is \$135 per couple (plus \$7 processing fee). **For details and to register go to**

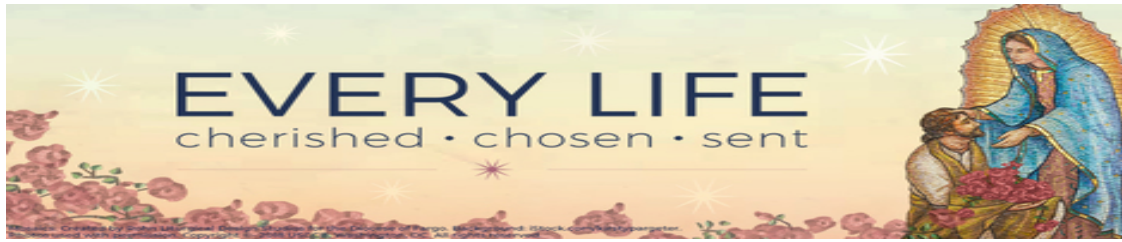
